"Exposure and Processing - a Tech Sampler."

"Digital cameras have extremely sophisticated exposure systems, but for best results (and most fun) you should personalize your exposures by taking the camera off Matrix, Evaluative, etc. exposure patterns and use center-weighted or spot, especially with Live View cameras. However, there are also new tech tools in today's cameras that help photographers overcome the barriers that high contrast placed in their way in the past. Other considerations will be noise, ISO, and tone compensation, plus a quick look at shutter speed and VR lenses."
